They stumble NIV because they disobey the message-which is also what they were destined for. And, "He is the stone that makes people stumble, the rock that makes them fall." They NLT stumble because they do not obey God's word, and so they meet the fate that was planned for them. And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, KJV being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.
