Greek	Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἡσυχίου πνεύματος, ὃ ἐστίν greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐνώπιον τοῦ greek The definite article θεοῦ greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God πολυτελής.
