	Different from εἶμι (which means "to be" - a state of existence); γίνομαι, instead, emphasizes coming to be - a transition or event.

ESV	The definite article ποιμνίου·
	not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock.
	NIV
	not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.
	NLT
KJV	Don't lord it over the people assigned to your care, but lead them by your own good example.
	Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being ensamples to the flock.

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
