εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐξ Αρμαθαιμ Σιφα ἐξ ὅρους Εφραιμ καὶplugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigκαί

LXX

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" ὄνομα αὐτῷρlugin-autotooltip_default plugin-autotooltip_bigαὐτός

Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament.
