	יהוה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name Hebrew It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.Exodus 3:14Deuteronomy 6:4Psalm 23:1Romans 10:13Joel 2:32Exodus 20:7Psalm 18:1Exodus 15:3Psalm 8:1Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3Judges 6:24Genesis 22:14Jeremiah 23:6 Messiah means “anointed one” The Greek word is Christ (Χριστός) Masculine, noun

NIV	Samuel said to them, “The LORD is witness against you, and also his anointed is witness this day, that you have not found anything in my hand.He is witness,” they said.
