For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (הָעֵם לְאֹמֶר אֲרוּר הָאִישׁ אֲשֶׁר יֹאכֵל לֶחֶם הַיּוֹם וַיֵּעַף הָעֵם
