ESV	They struck down the Philistines that day from Michmash to Aijalon. And the people were very faint.
NIV	That day, after the Israelites had struck down the Philistines from Micmash to Aijalon, they were exhausted.
NLT	They chased and killed the Philistines all day from Micmash to Aijalon, growing more and more faint.
