In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. Hebrew For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by אֱלֹהִים (דָּוִד בִּאלֹהָיו hebrew Meanings: * God * god * goddess * divine ones * angels Noun, masculine

Occurs 703 times in the New Testament. πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. At its core, it usually describes movement or relationship toward someone or something, whether physical, s... Δαυὶδ ὥσεί κύων ἐγὼ εἰμι plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big εἰμί greek εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense.
