The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֶא אֱלֹהֵים (הַחֲנִּׁית וַיִּּאֹמֶר אַכֵּה בְדָוֶד וּבַקֶּיר וַיִּפְּׁב דְּוֶד וּבַקּיר וַיִּפְּׁב הָבְיֶר וַיִּפְּב מָפְנֵיו פַּעֲמֵיִם מָפָּנֵיו פַּעְמֵיִם
