ESV	But if I say to the youth, 'Look, the arrows are beyond you,' then go, for the LORD has sent you away.
NIV	But if I say to the boy, 'Look, the arrows are beyond you,' then you must go, because the LORD has sent you away.
NLT	But if I tell him, 'Go farther- the arrows are still ahead of you,' then it will mean that you must leave immediately, for the LORD is sending you away.
LXX	ἐὰν τάδε εἶπω τῷ greek The definite article νεανίσκῳ ὧδε ἢ greek The definite article σχίζα ἀπὸ σοῦ καὶ greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐπέκεινα πορεύου ὅτι ἐξαπέσταλκέν σε κύριος
