Hebrew	The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (כָּל הָעָם לַמִּלְחָמָה לְרִדְתָּ קַעִילָה לְצֹר אֶל דָּוִד וְאֶל אַנְשָׁיו
ESV	And Saul summoned all the people to war, to go down to Keilah, to besiege David and his men.
NIV	And Saul called up all his forces for battle, to go down to Keilah to besiege David and his men.
NLT	So Saul mobilized his entire army to march to Keilah and besiege David and his men.

	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
