	The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים (קּוֹל דָּוִּד וַיֹּאֹמֶר הַקּוֹלְדָּ זֶה בְּנֵי הַמֶּלֶדְּ

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. φωνή σου αὕτηpluginautotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigοὖτος / αὕτη /τοῦτο

Demonstrative pronoun.
