Hebrew	את plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (דָּוָד בַּמִּדְבָּר זִיף)
ESV	So Saul arose and went down to the wilderness of Ziph with three thousand chosen men of Israel to seek David in the wilderness of Ziph.
NIV	So Saul went down to the Desert of Ziph, with his three thousand chosen men of Israel, to search there for David.
NLT	So Saul took 3,000 of Israel's elite troops and went to hunt him down in the wilderness of Ziph.
