Hebrew	* To kneel * To bless God as an act of adoration * To bless man as a benefit * Sometimes, to curse Verb, appearing approximately 330 times in the Old Testament. The word ברוך marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. Genesis 1:28 Psalm 103:1 Numbers 6:24 אתה בני דוד גם עשה תעשה וגם יכל תוכל וגלך דוד לדרלו ושאויל שב למקומו
