	The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by (צִקְלָג לְדֹר הַיְּתֵה) הָאֱלֹהִים בָּרָא אֶת-הַמָּקוֹם plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big

	The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 צִקְלָג לְמַלְכֵי יְהוּדָה עַד הַיּוֹם הַזֶּה
ESV	So that day Achish gave him Ziklag. Therefore Ziklag has belonged to the kings of Judah to this day.
NIV	So on that day Achish gave him Ziklag, and it has belonged to the kings of Judah ever since.
NLT	So Achish gave him the town of Ziklag (which still belongs to the kings of Judah to this day),
