	The Hebrew אַת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֶא אֱלֹהֵים (מֶחָנֵיהֶם לַצְּבָּא לְהָלָחֵם בְּיִשְׂרָאֵל וַיָּאֹמֶר אָכִישֹׁ אֶל דְּוִֹד יְדָע תַּדִּע כֵּי אָתִּוֹ תַּצְא בְמַחֲלֶה אֵלְהֵים (מֶחְנֵיהֶם לַצְּבָּא לְהָלָחֵם בְּיִשְׂרָאֵל וַיָּאֹמֶר אָכִישֹׁ אֶל דְּוֹד יְדָע תַּדִּע כֵּי אָתִּוֹ תַּצְא בְמַחֲלֶה אַלְּמֵיד
