Hebrew	The Hebrew את־ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרָא אֱלֹהִים (עֲצַמְתֵּיהֶם וַיִּקְבְּרוּ תַּחַת הָאֶשֶׁל בְּיַבֶּשֶׁה וַיֵּצְמוּ שִׁבְעַת יָמִים

NIV	Then they took their bones and buried them under a tamarisk tree at Jabesh, and they fasted seven days.
NLT	Then they took their bones and buried them beneath the tamarisk tree at Jabesh, and they fasted for seven days.
