It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word מָּוֹח (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again.
