	הָיָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 וְשֵׁם בְּנוֹ הַבְּכוֹר יוֹאֵל וְשֵׁם מְשֻׁנְהוֹ אֲבִיָּה שְׁפָטִים בְּבֵאֵר שֶׁבַע
ESV	The name of his firstborn son was Joel, and the name of his second, Abijah; they were judges in Beersheba.
NIV	The name of his firstborn was Joel and the name of his second was Abijah, and they served at Beersheba.
NLT	Joel and Abijah, his oldest sons, held court in Beersheba.
