εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example

εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἰδοὺ κατὰ πρόσωπον ὑμῶν νῦν διὰ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big

Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation.
