Usage in the New Testament The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable. 	Meaning: * These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it Demonstrative pronoun. οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 γὰρ θέλημα θεοῦplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigθεός greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God ἐνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigἐν greek Preposition meaning “in”. Χριστῷplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigΧριστός Christ means “anointed one” The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ) Noun, masculine. Ἰησοῦ εἰς ὑμᾶς.
ESV	give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
NIV	give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

NLT	Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus.
KJV	In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

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
