	Usage in the New Testament
	The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
	With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 εἶδους πονηροῦ ἀπέχεσθε.
ESV	Abstain from every form of evil.
NIV	Avoid every kind of evil.
NLT	Stay away from every kind of evil.
KJV	Abstain from all appearance of evil.

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
