ESV	Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and”
	νήφωμεν.
NIV	So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober.
NLT	So then, let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be alert and self-controlled.
NLT	So be on your guard, not asleep like the others. Stay alert and be clearheaded.
KJV	Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober.

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
