	greek Meaning * And * Also * Both * Even * Too * So Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as "and" εἰς ἐπίγνωσιν ἀληθείας ἐλθεῖν.
	ESV who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.
	NIV who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.
NLT	who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.
KJV	Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

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
