εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example $\epsilon i \mu i$ is the word for am and $\tilde{i} \nu$ is the word for was, e.g. $\sigma \omega \tau \eta \rho \pi \dot{\alpha} \nu \tau \omega \nu \rho lugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip big<math>\pi \tilde{\alpha} c$

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of $\pi \tilde{\alpha} \zeta$ depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ἀνθρώπων, μάλιστα πιστῶν.
