	The Hebrew את word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.
	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (בֵּית יְהוּדָה וּבְנֵימִן מֵאָה וּשְׁמוֹנִים אֶלֶף בְּחוּר עָשָׂה מִלְחָמָה לְהַלָּחֵם עִם את plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big
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	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (הַמַּמְלָכָה לְרִחְבָּעַם
ESV	When Rehoboam came to Jerusalem, he assembled the house of Judah and Benjamin, 180,000 chosen warriors, to fight against Israel, to restore the kingdom to Rehoboam.
NIV	When Rehoboam arrived in Jerusalem, he mustered the house of Judah and Benjamin-a hundred and eighty thousand fighting men-to make war against Israel and to regain the kingdom for Rehoboam.
NLT	When Rehoboam arrived at Jerusalem, he mobilized the men of Judah and Benjamin- 180,000 select troops- to fight against Israel and to restore the kingdom to himself.
