This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 הָיָה וְהָאֱלֹהִים plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigהָיָה וְהָאֱלֹהִים
Hebrew	hebrew Meanings: * God * god * goddess * divine ones * angels Noun, masculine אֵת plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigאֵת hebrew The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (יִרְבְּעֵם וְכָל יִשְׂרָאֵל לִפְנֵי אָבִיהָ וַיְהוּדָה
