Hebrew	* Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. Exodus 3:14 Deuteronomy 6:4 Psalm 23:1 Romans 10:13 Joel 2:32 Exodus 20:7 Psalm 18:1 Exodus 15:3 Psalm 8:1 Genesis 2:4 1 Samuel 1:3 Judges 6:24 Genesis 22:14 Jeremiah 23:6
ESV	He walked in the way of Asa his father and did not turn aside from it, doing what was right in the sight of the LORD.
NIV	He walked in the ways of his father Asa and did not stray from them; he did what was right in the eyes of the LORD.
NLT	Jehoshaphat was a good king, following the ways of his father, Asa. He did what was pleasing in the LORD's sight.
