

יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יהוה

Meaning

* Yahweh - God's personal name

It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יהוה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. Exodus 3:14 Deuteronomy 6:4 Psalm 23:1 Romans 10:13 Joel 2:32 Exodus 20:7 Psalm 18:1 Exodus 15:3 Psalm 8:1 Genesis 2:41 Samuel 1:3 Judges 6:24 Genesis 22:14 Jeremiah 23:6 יהוה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יהוה

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The word יהי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament.

This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.

* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3 Exodus 3:12 Ruth 1:1 Isaiah 2:2 יהי plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big יהי

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Meanings

* Renew * Restore * Repair

Verb. Occurs 10 times in the Old Testament.

See also החדש (Strong's H2319) - meaning “new” - the noun / adjective form.

Examples

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אֶת־ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big

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The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ. Genesis 1:1 **בְּיִתְּךָ יְהוָה** plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big

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
