Hebrew	הָיָה plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigהָיָה? hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word הָיָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. IT is most frequently translated as “and” ἐποίησεν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigποιέω Meaning: * To do * To make This verb - to do or make - is used in connection with a large range of activities including creation, covenant formation, obedience, miracles, sin and worship.
