	* Yahweh - God's personal name
	It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוָֹה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

ESV	The number of the burnt offerings that the assembly brought was 70 bulls, 100 rams, and 200 lambs; all these were for a burnt offering to the LORD.

NLT	The people brought to the LORD 70 bulls, 100 rams, and 200 male lambs for burnt offerings.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ταῦταρlugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigοὖτος / αὕτη /τοῦτο

\* These or this \* This one, this person, this thing \* They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὖτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — "this" as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19
