The word בָּרַךְ marks important moments of covenant, worship, inheritance and hope. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by יְהוָה (אֱלֹהִים) plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big הָיָה hebrew Meaning * Yahweh - God's personal name It is not a generic term for “god”, but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament. First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament.
