Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּיַד וַיַּשֶּׁם הָאֱלֹהִים אֶת הַמָּיִם וַיַּבְרֵם אֶת הָאֲדָמָה וַיִּבְרָא אֶת הַבְּהֵמָה וְאֶת הָעוֹף בַּשָּׁמַיִם וְאֶת אָדָם בְּיַד אֱלֹהִים (אֶת־כְּשִׁיִּים כְּשִׁדִּים וְהָרַג בַּחֲרוֹתָם בְּחֶרֶב בְּנֵי מִסְדֵּשִׁים וְלֹא חָסַל עַל בָּחוּר וּבְתוּלָה וְזָקֵן וַיִּשֶׁם הָאֱלֹהִים כֹּל בְּיָדוֹ
ESV	Therefore he brought up against them the king of the Chaldeans, who killed their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary and had no compassion on young man or virgin, old man or aged. He gave them all into his hand.
NIV	He brought up against them the king of the Babylonians, who killed their young men with the sword in the sanctuary, and spared neither young man nor young woman, old man or aged. God handed all of them over to Nebuchadnezzar.
NLT	So the LORD brought the king of Babylon against them. The Babylonians killed Judah's young men, even chasing after them into the Temple. They had no pity on the people, killing both young men and young women, the old and the infirm. God handed all of them over to Nebuchadnezzar.

KJV Therefore he brought upon them the king of the Chaldees, who slew their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary, and had no compassion upon young man or maiden, old man, or him that stooped for age: he gave them all into his hand.
