It is not a generic term for "god", but rather the word יְהוָה (YHWH) is the name by which God uniquely identifies himself in the Old Testament.

#### hebrew

The Hebrew אֵת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.

For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by אֱלֹהֵים ( בֹּוּחַ plugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip big בְּרֵא אֱלֹהֵים

## Meaning:

\* Wind \* Breath \* Spirit

Noun. Occurs about 380 times in the Old Testament.

Preposition that relates to movement through space, time, means or cause - it's a preposition of movement and mediation.

Adjective.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of  $\pi\alpha$  depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.
