	הִיְהִי־לָּהּ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big הִיְהִי hebrew The word הִיְהִי means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 עֵינֶיךָ פְּתֹחוּת אֶל הַמָּקוֹם הַזֶּה אֶל הַבַּיִת הַזֶּה יוֹמָם וָלַיְלָה אֶל הַמָּקוֹם אֲשֶׁר אָמַרְתָּ לְשׁוֹם שְׁמֶךָ שָׁם לְשִׁמוּעַ אֶל הַתְּפִלָּה אֲשֶׁר יִתְפַּלֵּל עִבְדְּךָ אֶל הַמָּקוֹם הַזֶּה
ESV	that your eyes may be open day and night toward this house, the place where you have promised to set your name, that you may listen to the prayer that your servant offers toward this place.
NIV	May your eyes be open toward this temple day and night, this place of which you said you would put your Name there. May you hear the prayer your servant prays toward this place.
NLT	May you watch over this Temple day and night, this place where you have said you would put your name. May you always hear the prayers I make toward this place.

	εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).
	It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὁφθαλμούς σου ἀνεωγμένους ἐπὶ τὸνplugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὁ
