The definite article εἶναι plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigεἶμί

εἶμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἶμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ὀφθαλμούς σου ἀνεωγμένους ἐπὶ τὸν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ

* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὔτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19 ἡμέρας καὶ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigκαί

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” νυκτός εἰς τὸν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_bigὸ
