	ἀλλὰ αὐτοὶαυτός greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). Occurs more than 5,000 times in the New Testament. Core uses Function English Equivalent Typical Translation Example (Greek) Example (English) ἐνa greek Preposition meaning “in”. ἐαυτοῖς τὸa greek The definite article ἀπόκριμα τοῦa greek The definite article θανάτου ἐσχήκαμεν, ἵνα μὴ πεποιθότες ὦμενα greek είμι Greek greek είμι is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”). It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example είμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἐφ’ ἑαυτοῖς ἀλλ’ ἐπὶ τῷa greek The definite article θεῷa greek Masculine noun meaning: * A god or goddess * God τῷa greek The definite article ἐγείροντι τοὺςa greek The definite article νεκρούς·
