Meaning:

* These or this * This one, this person, this thing * They or he or she or it

Demonstrative pronoun.

οὗτος usually refers to something close to the speaker — “this” as opposed to ἐκεῖνος (John 9:161 John 5:111 Corinthians 15:501 John 4:9John 5:1Matthew 3:17John 7:26Luke 22:19

ἔρχομαι πρὸς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big πρὸς

Meaning

* To or towards * Pertaining to (genitive case) * Near to (dative case) * According to * About

Preposition. Occurs 703 times in the New Testament.

πρὸς is a common preposition in Koine Greek that carries different meanings. It most frequently takes the accusative case, but at times it takes the genitive or dative cases, giving it a different meaning again. At its core, it usually describes movement or relationship toward someone or something, whether physical, s... ὑμᾶς· ἐπὶ στόματος δύο μαρτύρων καὶ plugin-

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” τριῶν σταθήσεται πᾶν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big πᾶς

Meaning

* All * Every * The whole

Adjective.

Usage in the New Testament

The sense of πᾶς depends on whether it modifies a singular or plural noun, and whether that noun is countable or uncountable.

With singular countable nouns → "every" John 1:9John 3:16Romans 5:12Matthew 28:19Colossians 1:16Romans 3:23Romans 3:23John 3:16Colossians 1:17 ῥῆμα.

ESV	This is the third time I am coming to you. Every charge must be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses.
NIV	This will be my third visit to you. "Every matter must be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses."
NLT	This is the third time I am coming to visit you (and as the Scriptures say, "The facts of every case must be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses").
KJV	This is the third time I am coming to you. In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established.
