εἰμί is the first person singular verb for “to be” (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = “to be”).

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example

εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. μεθ’ ἡμῶν χάρις ἔλεος εἰρήνη παρὰ θεοῦplugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigθεὸς

Masculine noun meaning:

Is a conjunction that connects single words or terms or sentences. IT is most frequently translated as “and” παρὰ Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦplugin-autotooltip\_\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigΧριστός

Christ means “anointed one”

The equivalent Hebrew word is Messiah (מָשִׁיחַ)
