In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ. Genesis 1:1 הַבְּעַל מִיִּשְׂרָאֵל
ESV	Thus Jehu wiped out Baal from Israel.
NIV	So Jehu destroyed Baal worship in Israel.
NLT	In this way, Jehu destroyed every trace of Baal worship from Israel.
