Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ. Genesis 1:1 בְּשֵׁמֶרֶץ וַיִּמְלֹךְ יְהוֹאָז בֶּן־זַחְרְבָדָן
ESV	So Jehu slept with his fathers, and they buried him in Samaria. And Jehoahaz his son reigned in his place.
NIV	Jehu rested with his fathers and was buried in Samaria. And Jehoahaz his son succeeded him as king.
NLT	When Jehu died, he was buried in Samaria. Then his son Jehoahaz became the next king.
