Hebrew	hebrew The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ.Genesis 1:1 עַל הַסּוּסִים וַיִּקְבֹּר בִּירוּשָׁלַם עִם אֲבֹתָיו בְּעִיר דָּוִד

NIV	He was brought back by horse and was buried in Jerusalem with his fathers, in the City of David.
NLT	They brought his body back to Jerusalem on a horse, and he was buried with his ancestors in the City of David.
