First appearing in Genesis 2:4, it occurs over 6,000 times in the Old Testament. 	hebrew The Hebrew אֶת word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. It only ever occurs in conjunction with nouns associated with the definite article הַ. 	Masculine noun. The word is dual in form (ending in ים־) which normally indicates two things (like eyes and hands), however, however it functions as a plural. Deuteronomy 10:14 states that Genesis 1:20 Psalm 115:3 וַיֹּשִׁיעֵם בְּיַד יְרֵבְעָם בֶּן יוֹאָשׁ
