	This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.
	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2
ESV	And he did what was evil in the sight of the LORD, yet not as the kings of Israel who were before him.
NIV	He did evil in the eyes of the LORD, but not like the kings of Israel who preceded him.
NLT	He did what was evil in the LORD's sight, but not to the same extent as the kings of Israel who ruled before him.

It is distinct from ὅτι ("that," introducing indirect speech) and from ὅς as an interrogative in older Greek (meaning ἦσανplugin-autotooltip\_default plugin-autotooltip\_bigεἰμί

εἰμί is the first person singular verb for "to be" (εἶναι [the infinitive form] = "to be").

It an irregular verb, and, like English, changes significantly between person and tense. For example εἰμί is the word for am and ἦν is the word for was, e.g. ἔμπροσθεν αὐτοῦρlugin-autotooltip default plugin-autotooltip bigαὐτός
