This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence. * It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 הוֹשֵׁעַ עֶבֶד וַיָּשָׁב לוֹ מִנִּיחָה
ESV	Against him came up Shalmaneser king of Assyria. And Hoshea became his vassal and paid him tribute.
NIV	Shalmaneser king of Assyria came up to attack Hoshea, who had been Shalmaneser's vassal and had paid him tribute.
NLT	King Shalmaneser of Assyria attacked King Hoshea, so Hoshea was forced to pay heavy tribute to Assyria.
