ESV	The height of the other pillar was eighteen cubits, and on it was a capital of bronze. The height of the capital was three cubits. A latticework and pomegranates, all of bronze, were all around the capital. And the second pillar had the same, with the latticework.
NIV	[Each pillar was] twenty-seven feet high. The bronze capital on top of each pillar was four and a half feet high and was decorated with a network and pomegranates of bronze throughout. The other pillar, with its network, was similar.
ALT	[Each of the pillars was] 27 feet tall. The bronze capital on top of each pillar was 7-1/2 feet high and was decorated with a network of bronze pomegranates all the way around.

KJV The height of the one pillar was eighteen cubits, and the chapter upon it was brass: and the height of the chapter three cubits; and the wreathen work, and pomegranates upon the chapter round about, all of brass: and like unto these had the second pillar with wreathen work.

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
