In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence.</div> <div>For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בְּרָא אֱלֹהִים (יַעֲרֶהוּ וַיַּעֲרָה לְשָׁלָל מוֹאָב</div> |
