	For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by בָּרֶא אֱלֹהֵים ( יִשְׂרָאֵל דָּבֵק לֹא סֶר מִמֶּנָּה
ESV	Nevertheless, he clung to the sin of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, which he made Israel to sin; he did not depart from it.
NIV	Nevertheless he clung to the sins of Jeroboam son of Nebat, which he had caused Israel to commit; he did not turn away from them.
