Hebrew	אתָּ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big hebrew The Hebrew אתָּ word does not have a corresponding word in English. In Hebrew, it is a marker of the accusative, i.e. the word following it is the object of the sentence. For example, in Genesis 1:1 the word is preceded by יְשַׁרְאֵל דְּבַק לֹא סָר מִמֶּנָּה
ESV	Nevertheless, he clung to the sin of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, which he made Israel to sin; he did not depart from it.
NIV	Nevertheless he clung to the sins of Jeroboam son of Nebat, which he had caused Israel to commit; he did not turn away from them.
NLT	Nevertheless, he continued in the sins that Jeroboam son of Nebat had committed and led the people of Israel to commit.
LXX	πλὴν ἐν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek Preposition meaning “in”. τῇ plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article ἁμαρτία Ιεροβοαμ υἱοῦ Ναβατ ὃς ἐξήμαρτεν τὸν plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek The definite article Ισραηλ ἐκολλήθη οὐκ ἀπέστη ἀπ αὐτῆς plugin-autotooltip__default plugin-autotooltip_big greek Meaning * He, she, it * Himself, herself, itself * Same Personal pronoun (reflexive). KJV	Nevertheless he cleaved unto the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, which made Israel to sin; he departed not therefrom.

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
