Hebrew	הָיָה היה hebrew The word הָיָה means “to exist” or “to be” or “to become” or “to come into being” and occurs 3561 times in the Old Testament. This is the foundational verb of existence, identity, becoming and occurrence.
	* It is used in the creation narrative of Genesis 1, represented by the English words Genesis 1:3Exodus 3:12Ruth 1:1Isaiah 2:2 כָּאֲכָלָם מִתְנַזֵּיד וְתִמָּה צַעֲקוּ אֵלֵהֶם אֵלֵהֶם אלהים
	hebrew Meanings: * God * god * goddess * divine ones * angels Noun, masculine וְלֹא יָבִילוּ לְאָכֹל
	ESV And they poured out some for the men to eat. But while they were eating of the stew, they cried out, “O man of God, there is death in the pot!” And they could not eat it.
	NIV The stew was poured out for the men, but as they began to eat it, they cried out, “O man of God, there is death in the pot!” And they could not eat it.
NLT	Some of the stew was served to the men. But after they had eaten a bite or two they cried out, “Man of God, there's poison in this stew!” So they would not eat it.
